Documents to collect for DAPA...

Proof of relationship to a U.S. Citizen or Lawful Permanent Resident Child

- Child's Birth Certificate
- Child's Permanent Resident Card
- Child's Naturalization Certificate

Proof of Identity

- Birth Certificate
- Certified passport or a national identity document from your country of origin
- School or military ID with photo
- Any U.S. Government immigration document or other document bearing your name and photo (for example, a driver's license)

Proof of Continuous Presence in the U.S. since January 1, 2010.

- Passport with Admission stamp
- School records from the U.S. schools you have attended
- Travel records
- Hospital or medical records
- Official records from a religious entity confirming your participation in a religious ceremony
- I-94/I-95/I-94W cards (if any)
- Dated bank statements
- Tax Returns, paystubs, insurance policies
- Deeds, mortgages, rental agreements, or contracts
- Phone, water, or electricity bills


