Gathering Evidence

The Following Websites provide information on where to gather supporting evidence to show you qualify:

- ❖ Proof of Identity
 - ❖ Passport-Identification-Birth Certificate from [Home Country](#)
 - ❖ School or Military Identification
 - ❖ Any U.S. [immigration document](#) with photo and name
 - ❖ [Maryland Driver's License](#)
- ❖ Documents Showing relationship with U.S. Citizen or LPR child
 - ❖ [Birth Certificate of child](#)
 - ❖ [Copy of Green Card of child](#)
 - ❖ Naturalization Certificate of child
- ❖ Proof of Continuous residence in the U.S. for the past 5 years and on November 20, 2015
 - ❖ Rent Receipts, rental agreements, or utility bills such as phone, electricity, [water](#), [property tax](#), etc.

 - ❖ Records from a religious organization confirming your participation
 - ❖ Medical Records and insurance

Criminal Record (if applicable)

It is highly encouraged to see an attorney if you have a criminal record (please see slide “Maryland – Baltimore City Legal Services”)

- ❖ *Expunging your record?*

- ❖ *Expunging a criminal record removes the record from public view BUT IT DOES NOT REMOVE THE RECORD FROM VIEW BY USCIS. BEFORE you petition to expunge your criminal records, you should get 2 or 3 court certified, sealed, copies (“True Test” copies) of the final disposition of every charge.*
- ❖ *If you do not get court certified dispositions, USCIS may ask that you reopen the criminal case, which is very expensive or impossible.*
