Opening Remarks from Chair Dana Moore

• Chair Moore requested that Natasha Mehu, Caylin Young, and Bob Cherry share updates with members of the LCAB.

Overview of Mayor's 2022 General Assembly Priorities

- Natasha Mehu, Director of Government Relations for Baltimore City, provided an update on the status of the Mayor's 2022 General Assembly Priorities following the conclusion of the session.
- The presentation focused on the Mayor's public safety bills and budget requests.

Overview of Police Oversight Related General Assembly Bill

- Caylin Young, Deputy Director for the Office of Equity and Civil Rights, provided an update on legislation, HB 991/SB 441, that would have made changes to the Civilian Review Board but did not pass.
- While the administration opposed the bill as introduced negotiations to find a middle ground were unsuccessful.
- Legislation was passed that made clarifying changes to HB 670 (2021) which mandated local jurisdictions to establish Police Accountability Boards and Administrative Charging Committees.
 - Provisions extending the timeline for implementation while regs are being finalized were stripped from the bill.

Discussion of Outreach to Other Jurisdictions

• Bob Cherry shared that he is reaching out to law enforcement from other cities to present to the LCAB on methods of local control.

Next Meeting

• The April 29 meeting of the LCAB will tentatively include presentations from the Law Enforcement Action Partnership on methods of local control as well as LCAB committee discussions.
